Our Team

ESH Recovery Center is run by a team of staff and volunteers who have lived experience of addiction and recovery. Some of us have been in recovery since our teenage years, and others are parents whose families were impacted by addiction. We offer peer support, which can complement any treatment or clinical services you have received or are currently engaged in. We have a licensed drug and alcohol counselor on staff who can assist with referrals and evaluations.

Eligibility

To become a member of ESH Recovery Center, you must be:

- Between the ages of 15 and 24 years old
- In recovery from a substance use disorder
- Agree to abide by ESH Recovery Center's Code of Conduct
- Note: If under 18, parents must consent to their child's participation
