CyberSmart Educational Workshop

Diversionsary workshops for cyberbully and sexting behaviors

Administered by the Center for Family Services

FCIU offers a socio-educational workshop to addresses the needs of youth, ages 11-17 years old, accompanied by their guardians, who have engaged in actions that may be considered to be of harassment, intimidation, and/or sexual in nature via any digital device. The complete program will include two 90-minute workshops and some may be virtual.

Day 1

- Define cyberbullying and sexting
- Discuss the adolescent brain and the impact it can have on decision making
- Identify situations of cyberbullying and sexting
- Acknowledge the legal and social consequences of cyberbullying and sexting
- Identify ways to avoid creating or receiving cyberbullying and sexting messages

Day 2

- Identify how to use technology in a positive manner
- Identify how youth group members will personally commit themselves to stop or prevent cyberbullying and/or sexting
- Identify how parent group members will commit to strategies to support teen's efforts to commit themselves to stop or prevent cyberbullying and/or sexting
